Professor Maghnie is a professor of Pediatrics and PhD In Pediatric Endocrinology, Head of the Pediatric Clinic, Clinical Service in Pediatric Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism at the Giannina Gaslini Institute, University of Genoa, Italy. He is currently a Director of the Pediatric Residency Program at the University of Genoa, Italy, former Director of the Pediatric Residency Program at the University of Genoa, Italy (2008–2014), and former President of the Italian Society for Paediatric Endocrinology and Diabetology (ISPED, 2011-2015). He was also Chair of the ESPE website (2004–2008), a co-author of Yearbook of Paediatric Endocrinology (2004–2009), and a member of the ESPE Summer School Steering Committee (2010–2013).

Professor Maghnie's major research interests include growth disorders and their treatment and the management of pediatric pituitary disorders. He was the Co-Chair of the Education & Training Working Group of COST action BM1105 on GnRH Deficiency: Elucidation of the neuroendocrine control of human reproduction. He is the supervisor of several postgraduate research students and postdoctoral fellows working in his research group.
